01 How to use this sheet

Every Burdenoff product solves a different problem for a different buyer, and they all share one platform, one contact and one commercial model. Your job is not to know all 36 in depth — it is to recognise which one a conversation is pointing at, say the one line that lands, and introduce us. Each product also has its own one-page cheat sheet and a full partner playbook; ask for the one you need.

SCANNING FOR A FIT

Use the at-a-glance table on the next page. Match on the buyer and the problem, not the technology.

THEY SAID SOMETHING SPECIFIC

Use the signal index — it maps the phrases prospects actually use to the product that answers them.

YOU HAVE A REAL OPPORTUNITY

Ask us for that product's playbook, then introduce us. Commercials are the same across the portfolio.

One thing to be straight about. These products are new. There are no public reference customers to name yet, and you should not imply otherwise. What you can point to is the depth of what is built, the shared platform underneath all of it, and how quickly you can get a prospect in front of us.
